
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The H@H journey

Oxford H@H

Set up in 2021-3 pathways-virtual bedboard on EPR

Integrated into CCN team

Prior process in place for IVAB (unclear escalation-adhoc)

Gradually moved all IVAB into H@H following weekly governance meetings

2022- Direction to Administer forms to EPR drug charts and virtual bedboard.

Patients from tertiary centres had to have an OUH lead with prescribing completed locally.
